1. How to prepare for Board ?

I think the coaching is good enough. But you can look through the chapters in your textbook which is going on in the coaching. Last 1 month of hard work on boards is ~~good~~ sufficient.

2. How to prepare for JEE Main ?

To qualify JEE-Main clarity in every topic is necessary. Regular Revision of Theory & practice of questions from each chapter is more important than High-level questions.

3. How to prepare for JEE Advance ?

Try to solve all questions given by the teachers. Don't leave anything and prepare every chapter until you are fully confident about it.

4. Which is a better option ? A school synchronised coaching program or school separately along with coaching classes ? why ?

I think school should be separate from coaching. One should fully concentrate on JEE-Main & Advanced when in coaching and self-study is good enough for school.

5. How to manage our time table ?

The preference should always be given to IIT. Most of the time at home should be given to IIT-JEE preparation. Once done with coaching homework,

12. How to prepare for KVPY & olympiads?

Regular revision is the key so that by the time KVPY & olympiads come we are prepared. If the course is incomplete till then, we should look through the chapters ahead - Previous years.

13. Which chapters in Chemistry, Physics & Maths are most scoring? O.P.'s are also helpful.

Physics → Electrostatics, capacitors, circuits & waves, optics, magnetism & EMI. Maths → Conic Section, Probability, I.T.F., limits & continuity, A.O.D., vectors - 3D, ~~Coordinate~~ Matrices & Determinants - Chemistry → Chem. bonding, Coordinate complex.

14. How to prepare for inorganic & organic chemistry? Kinetics, most of physical chem.

Inorganic requires lot of reading and regular learning. Whole course should be revised 2-3 times. Organic requires practising more & more questions.

15. Which books should we refer for board & IIT Preparation?

The textbooks and 10 years for boards. For IIT → Physics → Servey Jewett, Maths → S-L. Loney. I.O.C. → J.D. Lee. O.P. Physical Chem. → R.C. Mukherjee.
